

ADVANCE NOTIFICATION TO STAKEHOLDERS

To Whom It May Concern

I am writing to provide you with information regarding Adelaide Cabaret Festivals upcoming outdoors venue 'The Famous Spiegeltent' in Elder Park. It includes details of closures affecting the River Walk and the southern end of the park, in addition to traffic conditions impacting the roadway into Elder Park.

Adelaide Cabaret Festival will open an external venue in Elder Park from Friday 7th June through to Saturday 22nd June 2019. Hours vary between **5pm – 1am** on weekdays and **12pm – 2am** on weekends.

The Famous Spiegeltent, an antique Belgium mirror will sit on a purpose-built site over the lower part of the Festival Centre's Terrace at the southern end of Elder Park, connected to the centre. Each night, the venue will come alive with programming which includes live, ticketed performances, free programming, a late-night club and DJs. This venue holds three to four different performances a night.

This venue is a licensed venue as a part of the Centre and a smoke free event. It is anticipated upwards of 900 people will attend the venue each programmed day. Capacity will be controlled and monitored throughout the event by security.

Please be advised that access to the following areas will be restricted from **MONDAY 27th MAY** through to **FRIDAY 31st MAY** for bump-in/ construction, and again **MONDAY 24th JUNE** to **FRIDAY 28th JUNE** for bump-out:

- Pathways at the southern end of Park 26 (Elder Park) *
- The River Walk directly in front of the Elder Park driveway
- The Elder Park roadway at various times for loading and unloading between 8am and 4pm
- Partial closure of the Adelaide Festival Centre Amphitheatre as an exclusion zone for the construction site.

**** Please also note that some of the pathways at the southern end of Elder Park will be within the Spiegeltent site and backstage area and will be inaccessible to the public for the duration of the build and throughout the event.***

In order to minimise the impact of the event on surrounding stakeholders, the following measures have been implemented:

- The event will adhere to City of Adelaide requirements and standard operating procedures
- Noise levels will be monitored throughout the event to ensure they do not exceed the maximum noise levels permitted by City of Adelaide.
