Leasing Attraction Street Precinct Fact Sheet



Nowhere else is like the West End. Its history as the city's post-war entertainment hub lives on in the high concentration of live music and dance club venues and a sophisticated emerging bar scene.

Once known as the seedier side of town, it is by day an entrepreneurial centre for progressive arts and cultural institutions including the Jam Factory, the Samstag Gallery and the Adelaide Fringe and Feast Festivals. The University of South Australia's west end campus has injected a fresh dynamic, which is attracting emerging media, architecture, design and arts studios. Recent landscape works have complemented the new UniSA development.
